In the last newsletter we offered some suggested responses. This is repeated on our website. We are not 'anti-tram' – we support the Queen's Drive Route in preference to the Clifton via Wilford route, as it has less of an impact on the whole of the local environment, important nature conservation areas and wildlife. This view is **supported** by environmental and wildlife preservation agencies. We believe the Queen's Drive route will also do a better job of taking more people where they want to go e.g. work and shopping areas.

Latest news is that scientific measurements from the Institute of Hearing Research confirm that the tram is noisier than **NET** would have you believe.
